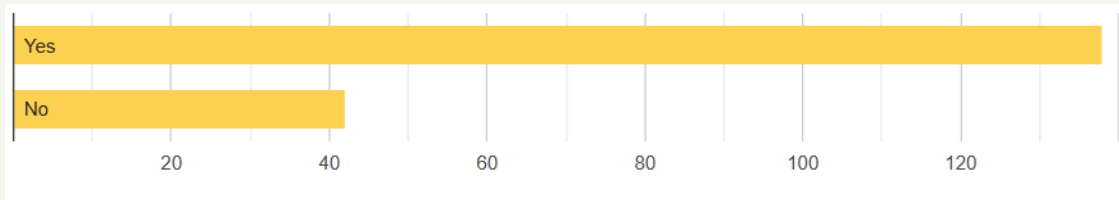
Jordans “new” Village Hall Project

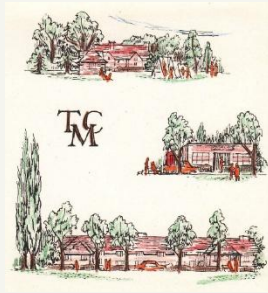

Roller Skating Social – Sat 1st Mar 17:45 – 21:00

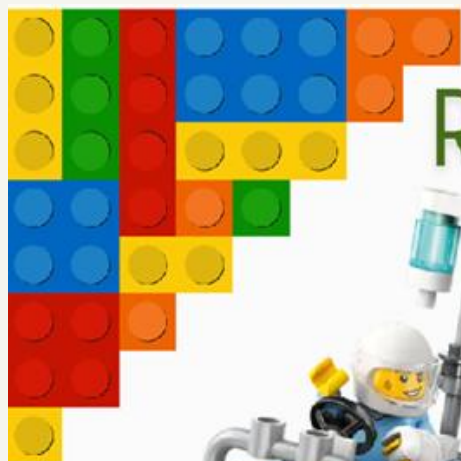

News from Manor Farm Field Biodiversity Project

As well as restoring nature, one of the most enjoyable things about the volunteer events on Manor Farm Field is the camaraderie of working alongside so many of you from Jordans and Seer Green in an act of collective activity. People of all ages - children to those in their 80s - bring their enthusiasm and love of the natural world. It's quite infectious :-)

On Saturday 18th January over 20 volunteers planted 370 whips (small plants) to create a scalloped edge of shrubs along part of the perimeter of Manor Farm Field north. Thank you! This will form an intermediate habitat between the vertical trees and hedges of the perimeter and the horizontal grassland. This is the 'magic zone' - food and shelter for invertebrates, birds and mammals - hopefully attracting new species and bigger numbers.

We didn't quite finish the job so please join us on...**Saturday 8th February 10am - 1pm**
We have the remaining 130 whips to plant and also will be trimming some of the hedgerow along the Seer Green footpath as part of the ongoing maintenance of this important habitat.

This is a drop in event - come for as long as you are able, there is no obligation to stay the whole time. Everyone welcome! We try to ensure there are tasks suitable for all abilities and encourage breaks, chatting and cake eating! Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult and no dogs please. Do let us know if you can come along so that we make sure we have enough equipment and refreshments!
