

Jordans Village Community Store, founded in 1922, is an independent community store, owned, operated and controlled by the Village. It is run by a combination of part-time staff and volunteers from the local community.

It started in a very small way in the front room of one of the early workers' cottages by the Village Green. In 1921, the brick building, now used as the Estate Office, was erected and a proper store opened.

The store is now a general grocers, with green groceries, an off-licence, a sub post office and café. It caters for online orders, and home delivery. The Store also serves as a natural meeting place for many of those living around the village, so why not come in and receive a warm welcome from our friendly staff and team of over 60 Village Store volunteers who are all eager to help you.

Decision time for Jordans Village Hall

Over the last few years there's been plenty of discussion about the future of the Village Hall – is it good enough as it is; should parts of it be renovated; or should it be demolished and rebuilt?

JVL's Management Committee now needs to decide the Hall's long term future, but wants to understand the views of village residents in order to make an informed decision. So early in January we will give each household a pack with a brief explanation of the options for the Hall, a short questionnaire, and a covering letter inviting each resident aged 16 or more to complete and return the questionnaire by 31st January.

We then hope that we can complete the analysis of the answers during February, and that the Management Committee will make its decision at the end of February. This is clearly a very important decision for Jordans Village, and we hope that everyone will participate in this consultation.

Jordans Village Hall Trust is holding a public meeting on Tuesday 22nd January, starting at 8 pm in the Village Hall, when the options for the Hall will be explained and there will be plenty of opportunity for questions and discussion. Please put the date in your diary and come to the meeting!

Jordans Village Concerts



However, once we're back (on Friday 1st February and ongoing) we would really like to have a few more helpers on board.


