
About your Village Store

Jordans Picture House extends its season

We are delighted to announce that the Jordans Picture House Season will be extended for an additional two months. The current programme would have finished in April with the screening of "*Hunt for the Wilderpeople*" on Sunday April 15th but the offer through Cinema for All of a catalogue of recordings of live performances from theatre, opera and ballet with relatively low licence fees prompted us to experiment with a pilot in May of three recordings of live performances from the National Theatre – an opportunity too good to miss.



FRIDAY May 11th - The Audience (PG)

Doors open 7:15 P.M. for 8:00 P.M. start

"For sixty years Elizabeth II has met each of her twelve Prime Ministers in a weekly audience at Buckingham Palace – a meeting like no other in British public life – it is private. Both parties have an unspoken agreement never to repeat what is said. Not even to their spouses. Dame Helen Mirren reprises her Academy Award winning role as Queen Elizabeth II in the

highly-acclaimed West End production of The Audience from NT Live." It would be interesting to speculate on the audiences with Teresa May, particularly on the topics of "strong stable government," the Union with particular reference to Scotland and Northern Ireland and any tips TM could give Betty on the next Prime Minister, as the Palace had a book running on it.



SATURDAY May 12th - The Deep Blue Sea (12A) Doors open 7:15 P.M. for 8:00 P.M. start

"Carrie Cracknell's critically acclaimed new production of Terence Rattigan's devastating masterpiece. When Hester Collyer is found by her neighbours in the aftermath of a failed suicide attempt, the story of her tempestuous affair with a former RAF pilot and the breakdown of her marriage to a High Court judge begins to emerge. With it comes a portrait of need, loneliness and long-repressed passion. Behind the fragile veneer of post-war civility burns a brutal sense of loss and longing." This play was "live streamed" recently to the community cinema in Cuddington and was well received. Alan Sealy and Chris Waymouth also saw the screening and were very impressed.



SUNDAY May 13th - No Man's Land (15) Doors open 3:15 P.M. for 4:00 P.M. start

Harold Pinter's comic classic with Ian McKellen and Patrick Stewart.

"One summer's evening, two ageing writers, Hirst and Spooner, meet in a Hampstead pub and continue their drinking into the night at Hirst's stately house nearby. As the pair become increasingly inebriated and their stories increasingly unbelievable, the lively conversation soon turns into a revealing power game, further complicated by the return home of two sinister younger men."

- 1. Tickets are priced at £10 each.
- 2. The May screenings are recordings of live performances from the National Theatre. The run time, including an intermission, will be around 2 hours 30 minutes to 2 hours 45 minutes.
- 3. Tickets are available either online or from the Box Office from March 1st.

The three plays we have chosen are all very different and, in addition, by offering three options over the weekend it will give the maximum practical opportunity for you to view one – or all of them.

This film has received widespread media coverage and probably as a result was heavily backed in your voting. It was top by a very considerable margin.

SUNDAY APRIL 15th Hunt for the Wilderpeople (12A) 2016

Cast: Sam Neill, Julian Dennison, Rima Te Wiata Director: Taika Waititi

A national manhunt is ordered for a rebellious kid and his foster uncle who go missing in the wild New Zealand bush. This film was well supported in the Vote but has received little media coverage. It is positive and happy and has outstanding ratings on the Rotten Tomatoes website – Tomatometer/Critics 97% Audience Score 91%

Critics Consensus:- The charmingly offbeat Hunt for the Wilderpeople unites a solid cast, a talented film maker and a poignant, funny, deeply affecting message.
